Effective January 1, 2014, the average Area 1 Inside Electrician Journeyman's wage is \$32.59 per hour as voted on and approved by the Area I Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee at the December 18, 2013 committee meeting. Please be advised that this is not a re-rate letter, this is a cost of living increase.

Area 1 apprentice' must be paid at least the hourly wage shown on the Wage Scale below.

Average Journeyman wage for 2014 \$32.59 per hour.
